Procedures for Extra-Curricular Activities

While you are enrolled at Independence Nontraditional, you are not permitted to be on any Prince William County School property without Permission from our Administrator, as well as the Principal of the school you are requesting to visit. These events include such activities as sporting events, Homecoming and Prom. In order for you to attend an event, you must complete a **“Request to Attend an Event on Another PWCS Property”**, form. This form can be picked up in the front office and must be completed in its entirety and turned in *one week before the event*. Students can check back two days before the event to see if his/her request was approved.

To be eligible to attend any event, student must meet the following requirements:

- Be in good Academic standing
- Have consistent Attendance
- Have no significant disciplinary infractions

Field Trip Eligibility Requirements

Students at Independence Nontraditional School may have one or more opportunities to attend Field Trips.

To qualify to attend a Field Trip, the following criteria must be met:

- Be in good Academic standing
- Have consistent Attendance
- Have no significant Disciplinary infractions
- Permission slip shall be filled out, signed by the Parent/Guardian
- Permission slip shall be turned in three days before the date of the Field Trip
- A current, signed Emergency Contact Card, must be on file in the Office

Requirements to Return to Base School for the Next School Year

- Earn 8 credits from for the school year
- Have a MAXIMUM of one (1) discipline referral during the School Year
- Sit for, and pass, all required SOL tests this year
- Attend all required SOL Remediation Sessions this year
- Have no more than fifteen (15) total absences, whether they are excused or unexcused
- Have no more than ten (10) total tardies, whether they are excused or unexcused
- Final grade in any class cannot be an “F” or “W/F”
- G.P.A. for the year must be equal to or 2.4 (C+)
- Student must be on grade level:
 - ❖ Students who will be 15 years old at the beginning of the next school year must have earned 6 credits.
 - ❖ Students who will be 16 years old at the beginning of the next school year must have earned 11 credits.
 - ❖ Students who will be 17 years old (or older) at the beginning of the next school year must have earned 16 credits.
- Complete an application to return to base school and submit it on time in May.
