





## Seek emergency medical care immediately if you have:

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face

This list is not all possible symptoms. Please call your medical provider for any other symptoms that are severe or concerning to you.

Call 911 or call ahead to your local emergency facility. Notify the operator that you are seeking care for someone who has or may have COVID-19.

# Food & Samuel Constraints of the Constraints of the

Anyone in the Greater Prince William area in need of food can call the **Community Feeding Task Force Helpline at (703) 794-4668**. Agents will help callers connect with their nearest food pantry or assist with scheduling a direct delivery if they have an emergency food need, have no transportation, or can't leave their homes for health reasons.

Manassas Park residents will be redirected to the Manassas Park Helpline: (703) 335-8802 or CMP-food@manassasparkva.gov.

Individuals 65+ years old will be redirected to ACTS/NVFS HRC to register for Direct Delivery.

- <u>ACTS Food Assistance</u>: clients are eligible to obtain food assistance through the Hunger Prevention Center
- NVFS Hunger Resource Center: clients are eligible to obtain food assistance through the SERVE Campus
- **Grab & Go Meals** for those 18 years old & younger:
  - Prince William County Public Schools
  - Manassas City Public Schools
  - Manassas Park City Public Schools
- <u>Capital Area Food Bank</u> COVID-19 Response Updates








#### COVID-19 in Virginia: Cases
